

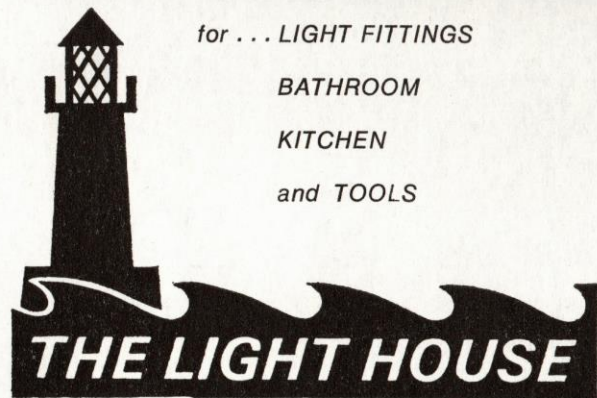

TARTUFFE was first performed before Louis XIV at Versailles in 1664. In order to appease clerical circles the King forbade future performances of the play ; but five years later he permitted it to be acted in public. Since that time TARTUFFE has been played consistently on the Continent, though seldom in England.
