The bar is open from 6.45pm until shortly after the end of the performance and drinking up time is 20 minutes.

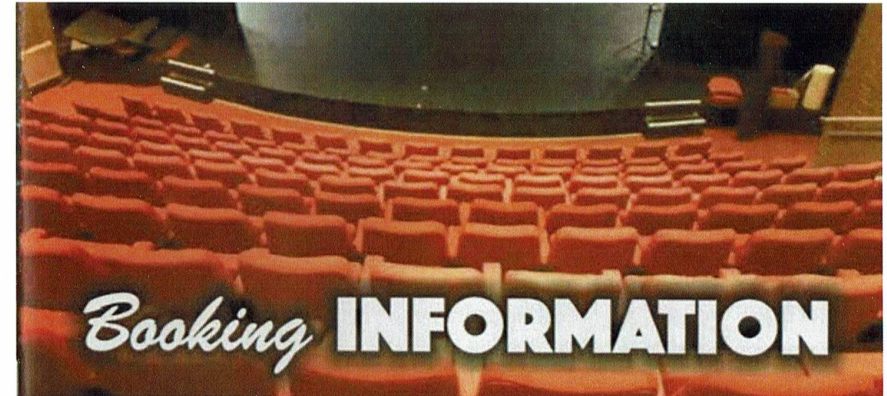
Coffee, tea and confectionery are available from the coffee bar from 6.45pm.

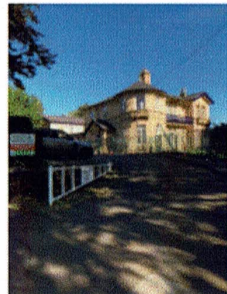

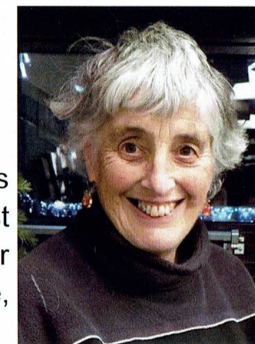

She previously belonged to the now defunct Tangents Drama Society and the Mow Cop Players, with both of whom she won best supporting actress awards in the North Staffs Drama Association's annual drama festival.
