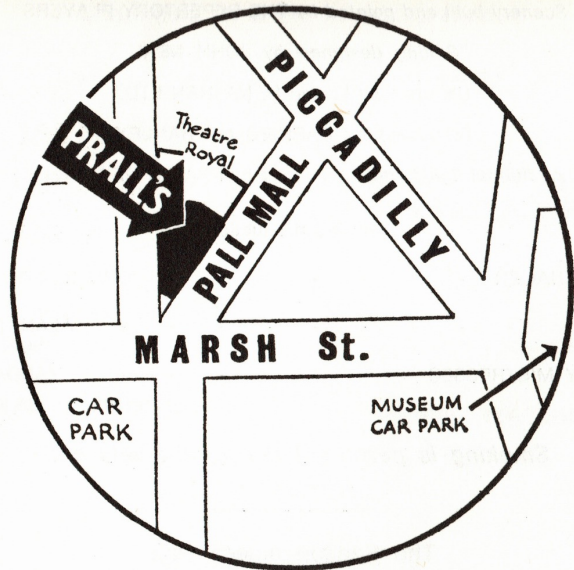

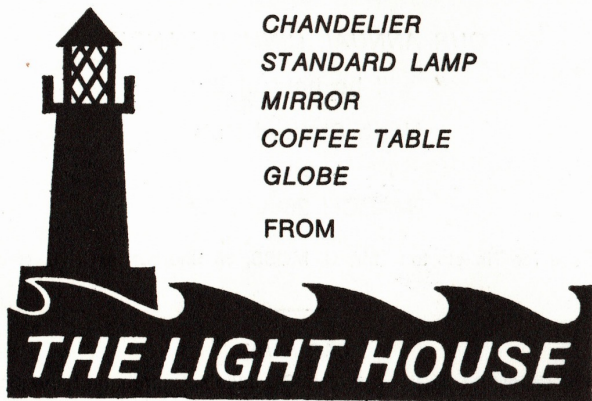
CAR PARK
